**Online School Enrolment process**

**STUDENT-CENTRIC**  
Online application form only asks questions relevant to the student.

**USER-FRIENDLY**  
Form is intuitive, clear and progressed can be saved and resumed later

**EASY ACCESS**  
Available through the school's website. Parents instantly know their in-area school.

**SAFE & FLEXIBLE**  
The form is secure, and can be completed on multiple devices anywhere and anytime.

The Online Enrolment System is designed to provide flexibility for our parents to submit an enrolment application online and at the time that best suits you.

The application can be accessed on all browsers and mobile devices including iOS and Android.

The online application process is currently restricted to:

- Enrolments into **local** schools only
- Children who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents
- Children who live in NSW.

We offer our support and encourage you to complete your application to enrol online. If, however, you do not

feel comfortable completing an application online, a paper copy will be available for collection from the front office or can be downloaded from the Department's [going to a public school site](#).
