## The Super Science Circus Show

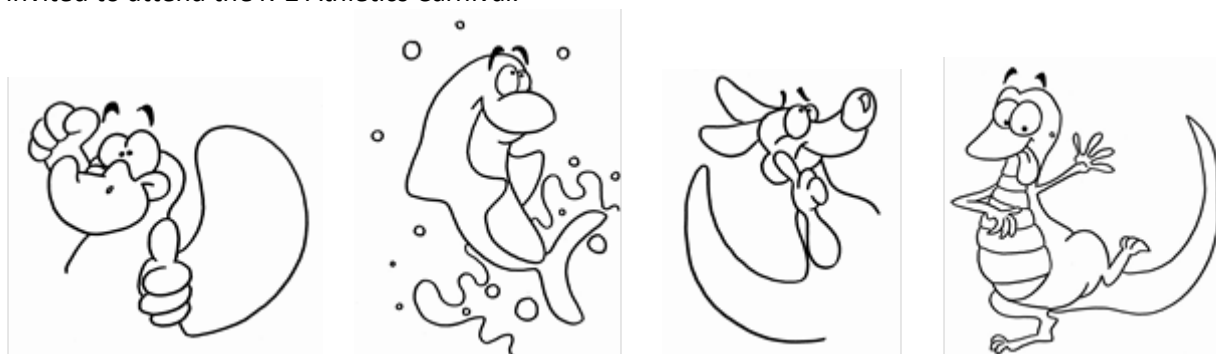

## K-2 Athletics Carnival

On Thursday 1 December, we will be holding our K-2 Athletics Carnival between 9 and 11 at school. Students will be advised of their house group and are asked to wear on the day a shirt of their house group e.g. goanna – green, kangaroo – red, platypus – yellow and dolphin – blue with their joggers, shorts, and their hat. The day will start with students sitting in their house groups and saying their house chants and then we will have age races. Students will attend a House meeting to learn their team's chants. After the age races we will have a short fruit and drink break and then students will be organised into year groups to complete athletics carnival events e.g., egg and spoon races, relays, etc. At Recess the carnival will conclude, and students will return to class. We aim to promote participation and engagement whilst participating in fun and safe activities. Parents and other family guests are invited to attend the K-2 Athletics Carnival.

## Out Of Zone Enrolment at Wadalba Community School

Wadalba Community School are currently receiving a high number of families contacting the school about enrolling their children into our much sought-after school. If you are interested in finding out exactly where our zoning is, please visit: <https://schoolfinder.education.nsw.gov.au/index>

Here are some key points around Non-Local Student Enrolments for Wadalba Community School.

- Wadalba Community School's current enrolment cap (the spaces available) is 1491 based on our permanent classrooms. Our school's current enrolments are 1650, therefore until enrolments are below 1426, the school is not in a position to enrol non-local students, **this includes non-local siblings**.
- The school has recently reviewed enrolment projections for future years. We have determined that Wadalba Community School will not have spaces available for non-local enrolments during 2022 and 2023. Unfortunately, this includes non-local siblings.
- If your family's current residential address is in the current intake zone, and you move outside the school's intake zone, younger siblings cannot be offered enrolment if no spaces are available for non-locals.
